





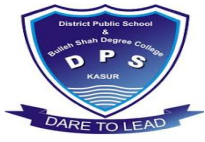

There are two types of memory, RAM and ROM. RAM is temporary storage area for the data. It means RAM loses data when the computer power is turned off. RAM is also known as volatile memory. It is high speed memory. It has three types DRAM, SRAM, MRAM.

ROM stands for Read Only Memory. It is non volatile memory. It means data in ROM does not lose its contents when the computer power is turned off. It saves data permanently. It also has three types. PROM, EPROM, EEPROM.
